Feline Neuter Discharge

Your cat has undergone a neuter (orchidectomy). This involves surgically removing the testicles through two small incisions in his scrotum. He has received ample pain killers while in our care. We are sending you with additional pain killers for 4 days while recovering at home.

To ensure the safe and speedy recovery of your cat, please follow these guidelines:

- 1. Feed and water him as normal. It has been shown that a cats energy requirement will decrease up to 30% post-neuter, because of this we recommend monthly weigh ins to ensure your cat is maintaining a healthy body condition.
- 2. Keep him quiet and discourage running and playing for 48 hours.
- 3. Discourage him from licking the incision.
- 4. Start the take home pain killers as directed.
